Gaudeamus hodie, nam surrexit sicut dixit.

I'm often accused of being behind the times because I don't use a lot of Latin so there you are. As a matter of fact, unlike most of the people who attend Latin Mass, I can sight read Latin, a requisite for anyone pursuing a doctoral degree in Canon Law. However, I choose to make use of the vernacular because people can understand what's being said without referring to one of those old-fashioned missals which had English on one side and Latin on the other. The Second Vatican Council asked us all to make use of our own languages but did suggest that everybody learn a few common parts of the Mass in Latin so we can "communicate" wherever we go. The Gloria, Credo, Sanctus, Pater Noster and Agnus Dei were recommended. (I hope you know what each of those is.)

Having used a Latin introduction to call upon all of us to "Rejoice this day for he is risen as he said," my prayerful congratulations to all those who either joined the Catholic Church or made a profession of faith in her at the Easter Vigil. Thanks to the team which supported them on their journey to the Easter Sacraments. As our parish grows, older, it is more and more essential that we invite adults to consider making their pilgrim way to the Kingdom with us in the Church so take time to prayerfully consider whom you might invite.

Although for many Christmas has become the most important Catholic celebration, Easter holds that position and should. It is the culmination of the so-called Triduum, the Three Days which follow Jesus along the way of his Passion, Death and Resurrection. The importance of those days isn't just to recall what Jesus did, but what we do. At baptism, we dive right into the same passion, death and resurrection event by the miracle of water and words and begin our unity with God himself. No gift at Christmas could top that!

Easter is also a time for family and that's part of the Church as well. Those who were baptized or made a confession of faith joined our spiritual family. You'll find their names elsewhere as part of our parish welcoming: I invite each of us to get to know them if we have not already done so since they've been coming to Mass since sometime last year when they began the studies and prayer which led them to the Vigil last night. My hope would be that together, we might have a program that grows each year and welcomes new faces, families and parishioners.

Have a blessed day and a wonderful Easter Season over the next few weeks.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



The Diocese of Toledo is in compliance with the articles of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People (Charter) of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

Every year, the Diocese dutifully submits the necessary documentation required by the USCCB for a diocese to be in compliance.

Every three years an on-site audit is conducted, when not only all necessary documentation is dutifully submitted, but in addition, Pastoral Center, parish and diocesan school employees are interviewed concerning practices and protocols related to creating and maintaining a safe environment for our children and youth.

The last 3-year audit was conducted in September 2024 and all audited Articles within the Charter were found to be compliant. The next on-site audit will be conducted in 2027.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric, or any personnel of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Children Services, and the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at (419) 214-4880 or by mail at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, Ohio 43604.

La Diócesis de Toledo está en cumplimiento con los artículos de la Carta para la Protección de Niños y Jóvenes de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB).

Cada año, la Diócesis presenta diligentemente la documentación necesaria requerida por la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB, por sus siglas en inglés) para que una diócesis está en cumplimiento. Cada tres años se lleva a cabo una auditoría en el sitio, en la que no solo se presenta debidamente toda la documentación necesaria, sino que, además, se entrevista a los empleados del Centro Pastoral, de las parroquias y de las escuelas diocesanas sobre las prácticas y protocolos relacionados con la creación y el mantenimiento de un entorno seguro para nuestros niños y jóvenes.

La última auditoría de 3 años se realizó en septiembre de 2024. La próxima audioría en el sitio se llevará a cabo en 2027.

La Diócesis de Toledo mantiene su compromiso de garantizar la protección de los niños y proporcionar un entorno seguro para todos los jóvenes.
