Dear People of God,

This weekend is the annual Blue Mass at our Sister Parish St. Patrick, a time to prayerfully honor the men and women who stand guard on our behalf in law enforcement here in the city and surrounding area. We certainly pray for the safety of those charged with protecting our lives and property: may they all always return to home and family alive and well.

That celebration gives me an opportunity to address a topic here at Immaculate Conception: the magnificent support of so many men, women and our friends in the community for our work here at the parish. Our recently completed and very successful Reverse Raffle met the unofficial goal of "Twenty-five in Twenty-five" with a final accounting of \$25,070. While to most of those who attend the gala event, it seems a wonderful one-night gathering for food, fun and (for the parish) funds, putting together the Raffle requires the work of a committee of dedicated people working for several months to procure the venue, the menu, the beverages, the auction items, and the all-important ads in the annual program.

There are a lot of people behind a successful Raffle to whom we owe a debt of gratitude and perhaps a willing desire to volunteer to "lend a hand," especially in traveling the town to recruit the advertisements which form a large part of our overall earnings. We urge those at the raffle to support our advertisers; better yet, perhaps all of us could find a copy of that program and do the same as a way to thank them for their support.

Speaking of volunteers to hit the streets, our Fall Fundraiser, the calendar raffle, could be a greater event if a few of our people volunteered to find a merchant or two who'd sell the tickets "over the counter;" such help would allow non-parishioners to become our partners in accomplishing God's work in the Old South Side. You'll be hearing about the ticket sales later this summer but now may be the time to think of those potential merchant helpers.

Of course, the real meat and potatoes of a parish are the regular offerings of the people in the pew. Sunday collections should, in the best possible scenario, meet all of the ordinary expenses of the parish: this generally means all the materials we need for Mission and Ministry, salaries for our employees, insurance on our buildings, utilities to keep us in a safe, clean church and small repairs anticipated because we know things will wear out over time. This year those regular Sunday offerings have certainly met the test: thanks to the careful stewardship of our resources by the Finance Council. we will end our fiscal year at the end of June "in the black." That means we will have spent less than we originally thought despite the advances of inflation. For that the administration gives prayerful thanks to all of you who have been part of the supporting community. Thanks to your generosity, we have been able to set aside a bit for those unanticipated major repairs so we'll begin our next fiscal year in very good shape. Thanks be to God and thanks to you for being such great members of the parish! 72 Chris

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.






