Dear People of God,

Greetings from Rome. As you read this, our pilgrimage group is returning from the massive gathering of men, women and children for the Jubilee of Youth and a final few hours open for visiting the sights in Rome before heading to the airport for our flight home.

Rome in August is typically hot and humid. Most Romans are to be found in the nearby Apennine Mountains where it's cooler and less humid; consequently, most of the people out and about are tourists and other pilgrims who came for the Jubilee of Youth. I'm always impressed by the vibrant faith shown by pilgrims from most of the world.

Young people are far more involved in church-related programs so hike together, camp together, sing together and don't mind being loudly open about it. Americans seem to be unbelievably quiet when compared and very few know any of the common hymns so can't join in on the street, the bus, the subway or at the many venues around the city. I've wondered how to address this after every World Youth Day I've attended but I have no easy answer.

On the other hand, one of the great things that happens at these events is the world-wide connections being made by our young people. Pope St. John Paul II urged the young people of the world to get to know one another so they can experience the universal call to holiness which is the Church. As tour leader, I do the same, asking the participants, whether young or old, to do a lot of meeting and greeting so that the sense of the true depth and range of the Body of Christ can be experienced and brought home from the celebration.

Another feature of the gathering is the huge numbers of people who seem to really enjoy two sacraments: Eucharist and Penance. The celebration of Mass is something to see, hear and feel as thousands come together to share the true presence of the Christ. I'm not sure of the numbers at the Mass but the field looked jammed; the last time I was out there for Mass, there were somewhere around three million people in attendance. And on occasion I've spent entire days listening to heart-felt confessions of sin and see the smiling faces of the reconciled. It's gratifying to know that around the world, the sacrament of absolution hasn't come on the hard times it has here in the US of A.

My thanks to all of you whose prayers have accompanied the Queen of Apostles students along the way from Assisi to Rome. I'm sure that they will profit from the pilgrimage and do great things for the community and the Church in Toledo as they continue to grow in wisdom, faith and knowledge.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults: OCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

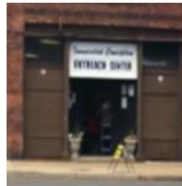

Bruxism. Bruxism is a condition where a person grinds, clenches, or gnashes his or her teeth. It can occur when awake or asleep. Bruxism that happens when a person is awake is more common, but bruxism that happens during sleep has been studied more. Children as well as adults can have this condition. Many cases of bruxism are mild and may not require treatment, however, severe bruxism can lead to damaged teeth, jaw pain or tiredness, and headache. Since it is possible to grind your teeth in your sleep or be otherwise unaware that bruxism is occurring, it is important to know the signs and symptoms and receive regular dental care.

The Diocese of Toledo is in compliance with the articles of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People (Charter) of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

Every year, the Diocese dutifully submits the necessary documentation required by the USCCB for a diocese to be in compliance.

Every three years an on-site audit is conducted, when not only all necessary documentation is dutifully submitted, but in addition, Pastoral Center, parish and diocesan school employees are interviewed concerning practices and protocols related to creating and maintaining a safe environment for our children and youth.

The last 3-year audit was conducted in September 2024 and all audited Articles within the Charter were found to be compliant. The next on-site audit will be conducted in 2027.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric, or any personnel of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Children Services, and the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at (419) 214-4880 or by mail at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, Ohio 43604.

La Diócesis de Toledo está en cumplimiento con los artículos de la Carta para la Protección de Niños y Jóvenes de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB).

Cada año, la Diócesis presenta diligentemente la documentación necesaria requerida por la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB, por sus siglas en inglés) para que una diócesis esté en cumplimiento. Cada tres años se lleva a cabo una auditoría en el sitio, en la que no solo se presenta debidamente toda la documentación necesaria, sino que, además, se entrevista a los empleados del Centro Pastoral, de las parroquias y de las escuelas diocesanas sobre las prácticas y protocolos relacionados con la creación y el mantenimiento de un entorno seguro para nuestros niños y jóvenes.

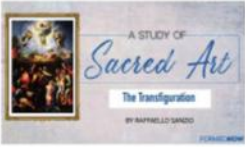
La última auditoría de 3 años se realizó en septiembre de 2024. La próxima auditoría en el sitio se llevará a cabo en 2027.

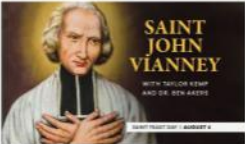
The Transfiguration | Sacred Art
