Dear People of God,

Later today the young and old who traveled to the Jubilee of Youth in Rome and venerated the tomb of Saint Carlo Acutis will be meeting to put together a few thoughts about their pilgrimage, share memories and put together a schedule for visiting the parishes to "tell the tale" of this amazing spiritual adventure. Here are a few observations of my own today.

Going to Italy seemed a distant dream when the idea was brought up over at Queen of Apostles, yet in a Year of Hope, trusting in the intercession of St. Carlo and the generosity of God and his people, the dream became reality. Six students, five chaperones, one aging Pilgrimage leader and twelve adults set off from Detroit. Arriving at Assisi, the pilgrims celebrated Mass in St. Sebastian's chapel beneath Mary of the Angels Basilica

As leader of the pilgrimage, I can report that the spirit of the young pilgrims was truly something to see and experience. I cannot say enough about the preparation for real life provided at Queen of Apostles. The students were attentive, followed the few rules set before we left and were gracious visitors who made many new friends while in Italy. Our young people endured the heat of the long walk to the Tor Vergata, a huge open area, actually a natural amphitheater, which is used by the University of Rome for athletic practice. Participating in the Jubilee of Youth, they remained joy-filled the entire way and then participated in the events with enthusiasm and excitement. It certainly affirmed that our Church has a brilliant future awaiting it and perhaps that future could be brought closer if all of us took time to read Pope Francis' thoughts on the full, active participation of everyone in the leadership roles of the parish and Church. The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults: OCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



Tuesday Mass: To offer a sense of security to the students, staff, and families of Queen of Apostles we ask that anyone that attends Tuesday Mass enter through the office door. All other entrances will be locked.





The Diocese of Toledo is in compliance with the articles of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People (Charter) of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

Every year, the Diocese dutifully submits the necessary documentation required by the USCCB for a diocese to be in compliance.

Every three years an on-site audit is conducted, when not only all necessary documentation is dutifully submitted, but in addition, Pastoral Center, parish and diocesan school employees are interviewed concerning practices and protocols related to creating and maintaining a safe environment for our children and youth.

The last 3-year audit was conducted in September 2024 and all audited Articles within the Charter were found to be compliant. The next on-site audit will be conducted in 2027.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric, or any personnel of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Children Services, and the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at (419) 214-4880 or by mail at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, Ohio 43604.

La Diócesis de Toledo está en cumplimiento con los artículos de la Carta para la Protección de Niños y Jóvenes de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB).

Cada año, la Diócesis presenta diligentemente la documentación necesaria requerida por la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB, por sus siglas en inglés) para que una diócesis está en cumplimiento. Cada tres años se lleva a cabo una auditoría en el sitio, en la que no solo se presenta debidamente toda la documentación necesaria, sino que, además, se entrevista a los empleados del Centro Pastoral, de las parroquias y de las escuelas diocesanas sobre las prácticas y protocolos relacionados con la creación y el mantenimiento de un entorno seguro para nuestros niños y jóvenes.

La última auditoría de 3 años se realizó en septiembre de 2024. La próxima audioría en el sitio se llevará a cabo en 2027.

La Diócesis de Toledo mantiene su compromiso de garantizar la protección de los niños y proporcionar un entorno seguro para todos los jóvenes. 


