Dear People of God,

The pilgrimage to Italy this past August inspires further consideration. A primary goal was to venerate the tomb of Carlo Acutis. Although born in England and raised in Milan, he is entombed in Assisi where his family often spent the summers. He was well-known there for his exuberant interest in the Eucharist, the real presence of Jesus the Christ in his life every time he accepted Jesus in the Sacrament. In just a few months before falling ill with a rare form of cancer, he researched and assembled the Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit



which the Queen of Apostles students staged at St. Jerome a month before they departed for Italy and which they will restage in the future to continue the evangelization of the True Presence.

St. Carlo is entombed in the church of Mary Major where St. Francis threw aside the encumbering garments of commercialism and materialism and took up the humble role of poverty speaking the gospel. It's a beautiful if small place; St. Carlo is off to one side and I must admit, passing by the tomb is a deeply moving and emotional experience for anyone who has spent any time at all learning about this amazing young teen. The photo here was taken just minutes before the pilgrims gathered to celebrate Mass in this ancient church.

The impetus for the pilgrimage came from the students at Queen of Apostles who should be thanked for their active participation in the Eucharistic

Renewal ending this year; I believe they were the only young people in our diocese to undertake a pilgrimage to Assisi and the Jubilee of Youth. The theme for the year is the proclamation of the real presence in our lives. The students and adults who traveled to Italy certainly understood that and lived it openly. Perhaps if all of us showed that same excitement and enthusiasm for bringing Jesus out the doors of the church and into the world, we could make a difference just as St, Francis and St. Carlo managed in life and now through their heavenly intercession.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults: OCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.






Divine Mercy with Fr. Michael Gaitley
