Dear People of God,



Concluding my series of comments on the Queen of Apostles pilgrimage to Italy, I now offer some thoughts on the Jubilee of Youth Vigil and Mass the Sunday before our return to Ohio. This event included a long walk from Rome proper to the place of the vigil, then an evening of prayer led by the Pope followed by an overnight experience of over a million people, all excitedly sharing their stories with others from around the world. There is, of course, the Jubilee Mass followed by the return trek to Rome. The idea is to recreate, at least in miniature, the ancient practice of pilgrimage, almost always as a penitential opportunity to reflect on one's life, goals and behaviors. Having been to one of these before (2000, the same venue at Tor Vergata) I was able to draw some comparisons, all of them favorable concerning the life of our Church.

Seeing smiling faces, prayerful demeanor and people, who with some excitement enter into prayer and song, suggests that the Holy Spirit remains close to all of us, even those whose exuberance has been tempered by the years. Twenty-five years older than I was in 2000 and far closer to the end of my life than the beginning, I can understand only too well why St. John Paul II always said that World Youth Day events gave him a renewed sense of his own youth and that of the Church Universal. I want to thank in particular Christian Parga whose study of Carlo Acutis gave birth to the dream and reality of the Pilgrimage. Perhaps he remains unaware of the powerful spiritual energy he brought to this opportunity; I hope some of it remains so that his life and example encourage others around him to live a life of partnership with Jesus. Let's all give that a try.

The Celebration of Sacraments

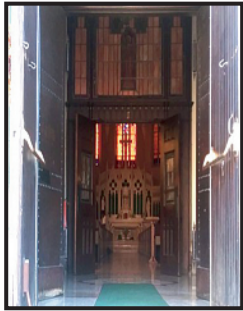
Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults: OCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

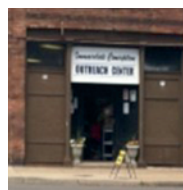

Health News for November 2, 2025



Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV). RSV is a common respiratory virus. It usually causes mild, cold-like symptoms. But it can cause serious lung infections, especially in infants, older adults, and people with serious medical problems. RSV is spread from person to person through:

- The air by coughing and sneezing
- Direct contact, such as kissing the face of a child who has RSV
- Touching an object or surface with the virus on it, then touching the mouth, nose, or eyes before washing your hands.

People who have an RSV infection are usually contagious for 3 to 8 days. But sometimes infants and people with weakened immune symptoms can continue to spread the virus for as long as 4 weeks.


