Dear People of God,

I thought I was at the end of the Rome trip; however, today the Universal Church celebrates the dedication of St. John Lateran, the cathedral church of Rome and thereby the Mother Church of all the dioceses and parishes which make up the Catholic Church. St. John is one of the Major Basilicas and one which includes a Holy Door which I can guess is quite busy today!

Celebrations of the great churches reminds us that we are one body in Christ, a Church consisting of all the men, women and children who profess their faith in Jesus Christ just as we do each Sunday. Without such events, it's too easy to become parochialized and focus our attention only on our local parish. That's a sad reality when it strikes because it sets aside the powerful energy of the whole; perhaps that's why we see so They many parishes' flounder and fail. cut themselves loose

Unfortunately it can also affect individuals who have no time for the Church beyond the minimal expectations of going to Mass now and then but expecting the Church to be ready to go at the drop of a hat for weddings, baptisms and funerals. A quote from the a person in charge of the recent Eucharistic event in Indianapolis is insightful: "What the recent (CARA) study shows is the deep need for a true Eucharistic revival, one that pushes past mere assent and awareness of the Church's teaching but is about providing an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist, leading to a lived relationship of discipleship."

The study reported that most Catholics believe in the real presence but don't know how to translate that into their active lives or explain it to others. In essence, the answer to moving from mere assent to living the Church class praxis (the way of life based on the real presence) is to be fully aware of the universal Body to which we as individuals and parish belong. At Mass do your best to feel the presence of a billion and a half others sharing that same Jesus and make a conscientious effort to give yourself to all those others so that in unity, you can experience the broader unity with Jesus. Awareness of others is key to being the person Jesus calls any of us to be: their needs become ours, the answers to problems seem clearer and genuine human progress can take place. It's easier than it sounds because in the presence of Jesus, truly and really present, all things are possible. a Chris

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults: OCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



The Diocese of Toledo is in compliance with the articles of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People (Charter) of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

Every year, the Diocese dutifully submits the necessary documentation required by the USCCB for a diocese to be in compliance.

Every three years an on-site audit is conducted, when not only all necessary documentation is dutifully submitted, but in addition, Pastoral Center, parish and diocesan school employees are interviewed concerning practices and protocols related to creating and maintaining a safe environment for our children and youth.

The last 3-year audit was conducted in September 2024 and all audited Articles within the Charter were found to be compliant. The next on-site audit will be conducted in 2027.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric, or any personnel of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Children Services, and the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at (419) 214-4880 or by mail at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, Ohio 43604.

La Diócesis de Toledo está en cumplimiento con los artículos de la Carta para la Protección de Niños y Jóvenes de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB).

Cada año, la Diócesis presenta diligentemente la documentación necesaria requerida por la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB, por sus siglas en inglés) para que una diócesis está en cumplimiento. Cada tres años se lleva a cabo una auditoría en el sitio, en la que no solo se presenta debidamente toda la documentación necesaria, sino que, además, se entrevista a los empleados del Centro Pastoral, de las parroquias y de las escuelas diocesanas sobre las prácticas y protocolos relacionados con la creación y el mantenimiento de un entorno seguro para nuestros niños y jóvenes.

La última auditoría de 3 años se realizó en septiembre de 2024. La próxima audioría en el sitio se llevará a cabo en 2027.

La Diócesis de Toledo mantiene su compromiso de garantizar la protección de los niños y proporcionar un entorno seguro para todos los jóvenes.
